Hazards and controls for vehicles

 Hazards in vehicle operations causing: loss of control and overturning of vehicles, collisions with other vehicles, pedestrians and fixed objects

✓ Safe traffic routes and safety signage, management
of vehicle movements, environmental factors (e.g.
visibility, gradients, changes of level, surface conditions),
maintenance of vehicles, driver protection and restraint
systems, means of segregating pedestrians and vehicles,
protective measures for people and structures (e.g.
barriers, marking signs, warnings of vehicle approach and
reversing), site rules, driver competence
